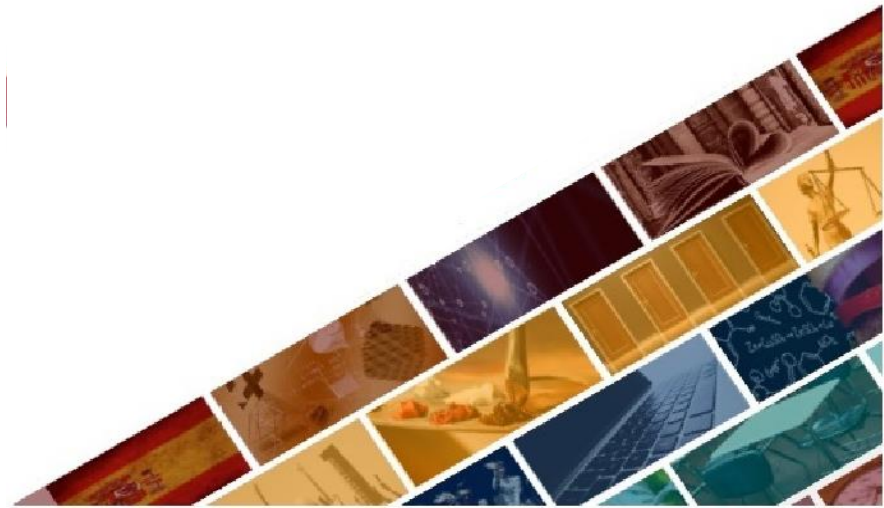

A-Level Law

Subject Information

A Level Law is **100% exam** and consists of **THREE** papers: criminal law, tort law and human rights law. Exam papers consist of multiple choice, short answer questions, scenario questions and extended essay questions.

- **Exam board:** AQA option B (human rights)
- **Module structure:** paper 1 criminal law, paper 2 tort law and paper 3B human rights law

Overview of subject content:

- **Year 12**– Law Making and The English Legal System, non-fatal offences including assault and GBH, and tort law.
- **Year 13**– Criminal offences such as murder, manslaughter, theft and robbery, defences, tort law and Human Rights.

Entry requirements

Pathway 1 entry requirements: 8+ GCSEs at Grade 6 and above including English and Maths.

Subject entry requirements: 5 GCSE's at grade 6 and above including English, and a grade 5 or above in a Humanities subject (History, Geography or Religious Studies)
