This course allows students to broaden their knowledge of the legal sector as well as developing skills in analysis, evaluation and application of the law.

- **Exam board:** Pearson
- **Module structure:** in Btec Applied Law you will cover four units. Two will be internally assessed and Two externally assessed. Externally assessed unit exams take place in January or June.

Course Description:

In year 12 you will study 2 units:

Unit 1: Dispute solving in civil law (externally assessed)

Unit 2: Understanding law making and the legal system (internally assessed)

In year 13 you will study a further 2 units:

Unit 3: Apply the law (externally assessed)

Unit 4: aspects of family law (internally assessed)



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Entry requirements

Pathway 2 entry requirements: 5 GCSEs (or equivalent) at Grade 4/Level 2 Pass and above

Subject entry requirements: 5 GCSEs at grade 5 and above including English, and a grade 5 or above in a Humanities subject (History, Geography or Religious Studies)
