

Secondary Ready Catch-Up 2018-19

Grant Allocation £22,000

Secondary Ready Reading and Maths

Forty-Four pupils were placed in an intensive literacy and numeracy pathway with low student to teacher ratios based on the primary model. Twenty of these students have already left this pathway as their progress in literacy and numeracy has improved and they met their end of year targets. Last year 62% of these pupils met their ambitious progress targets for English and 49% of met these in maths.

Pupils in mainstream had additional literacy and maths intervention from designated maths and English mentors. Those who work is still below age related levels and targets will continue with additional 1-2-1 tuition as necessary.

Students who were behind in reading and were given an intensive reading intervention to raise their reading age to their biological age with an English reading mentor and in 2019 this program will be rolled out to all Year7 Pupils to support the development of reading in their Period 1 Curriculum time.

We will continue this model of catch up in the next academic year as the programme has improved the skills of these individuals to secondary ready and develop the reading programs further with the English dept. in year 7 Period 1 time.
