Overview:

Graphics consists of 4 units. To be awarded a Level 2 Technical Award in this subject, students are required to complete all 4 units and achieve a minimum of a Pass in the external assessment.

Unit 1 – Introduction to Graphic Design

6 components of Graphic Design 1

Produce a ppt that describes the use and role of colour, tone, line, composition, typography and imagery in graphic design. This must include annotated visual examples.

Make links between the 6 components and explain how they work together to create a final piece e.g. typography and colour, image and composition etc.

Magazine Front Cover

Experiment with colour, tone, line, composition, typography, and imagery for a magazine front cover

Explain the impact of the changes made, which is preferred and why.

Review of unit

Review the experiments, commenting on the impact of the 6 graphic design components and explaining the changes made. Also, review the choices made when selecting tools and techniques to create the front cover

Unit 2 – Graphic Design Practice

Understand the work of graphic Designers

Choose an area of graphic design and research 3 designers working in that field.

Use different sources for information.

Comment on the designer's style and use of the 6 components of graphic design.

Produce work in the style of one designer

Produce a piece of work inspired by one of the graphic designers researched, reflecting their use of the 6 components.

Review

Review your work commenting on:

- How the design reflects the work of the graphic designer
- Technical skills
- Use of 6 graphic design components
- How the design could be improved

Unit 3 – Responding to a Graphic Design brief

Understand the requirement of a graphic design brief. Come up with your own brief for a new graphics

product and develop design ideas and a final version.

Analysis of the process, your technical skills and the final solution.

In **Nov/Dec** you will sit a Mock exam where you are given a brief and in exam conditions you come up with design ideas and a final solution.

In **February** you will sit your externally marked exam.

Unit 4 - Graphic Design Portfolio

Understand working in the graphic design industry

Describe job opportunities, entry and progression routes, physical and digital portfolios.

Produce a graphic design portfolio

Create your own portfolio of work including examples of work from school and work completed in your own time. Include a wide range of skills and justify the work chosen.

Review your skills

Analyse your strengths and weakness in relation to technical skills, creative responses, and presentation skills
