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Points to note

Supplementary courses:

- **Core Maths:** chosen as a fourth subject for 1 year. Strongly recommended for students studying Sciences, Psychology, Economics etc. who wish to progress to University.
- **Core English:** chosen as a fourth subject for 1 year. Strongly recommended for students studying humanities or related subjects who wish to progress to University.
- **Extended Project Qualification:** chosen as a fourth subject for 1 year. Strongly recommended for students who wish to progress to University.

Creative Media and Psychology: these courses appear in two blocks. The courses are identical and should only be chosen once.

Choose a maximum of 4 subjects:

- Applicants for Pathway 1 and 2 should choose 4 subjects, and leave 1 block empty.
- Applicants for Pathway 3 should choose 3 subjects and leave 2 blocks empty.

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Points to note

GCSE Resits: any student not achieving at least Grade 4 in GCSE English (Language or Literature) or GCSE Maths must take compulsory resit classes.

GCSE resit classes will be after the normal school day until 4 o'clock.

GCSE resits are considered a condition of entry to the Sixth Form for any student not achieving the minimum GCSE grade 4.



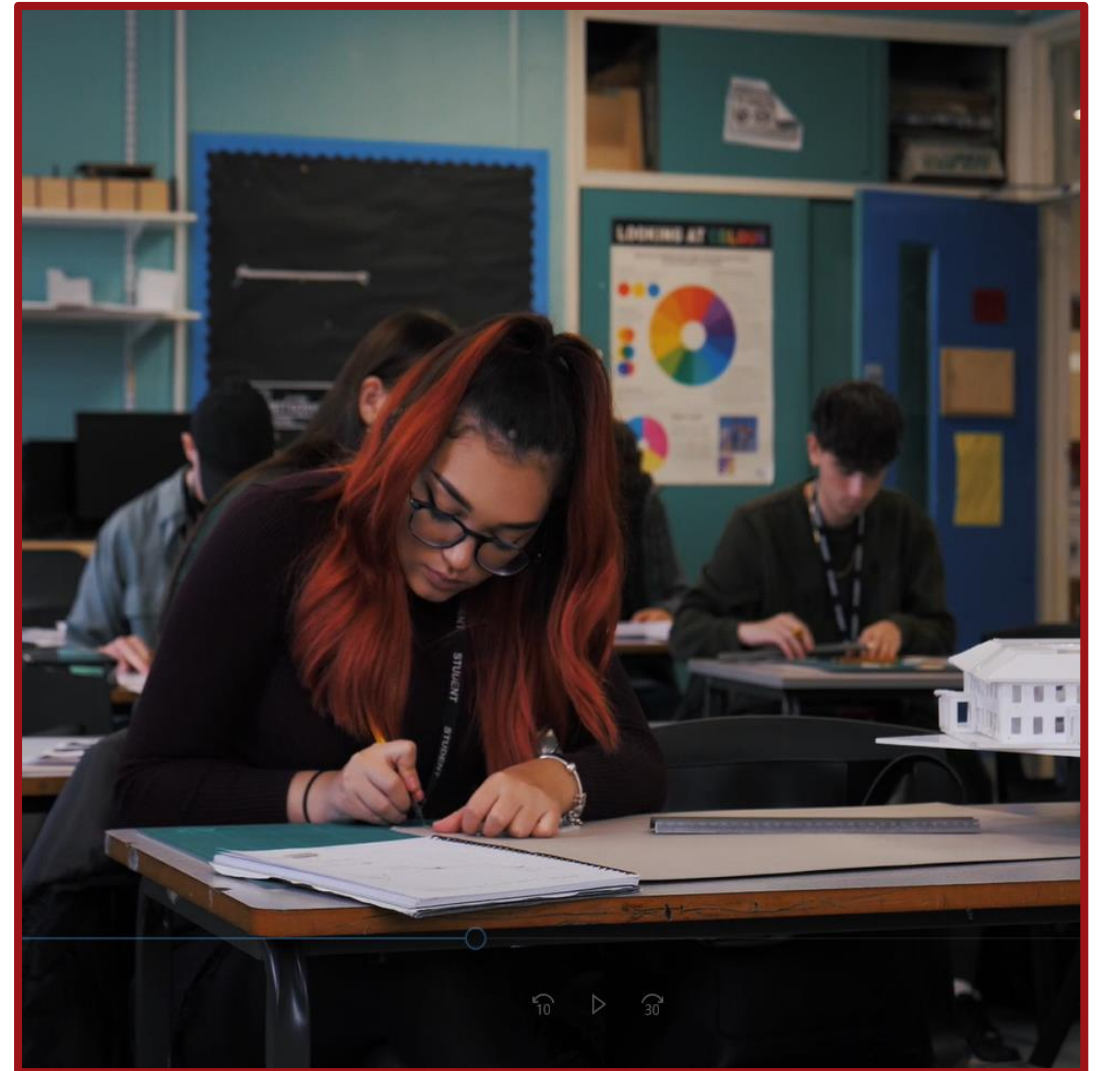
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Points to note

Maximum student numbers: Our most popular courses will often have full classes, with a maximum of 30 students for most subjects (although some specialist subjects are smaller).

All applications received by **17th December 2021** will be treated equally when offers are made.

Any applications received after this date will be subject to the number of students enrolling on individual courses on results day.
